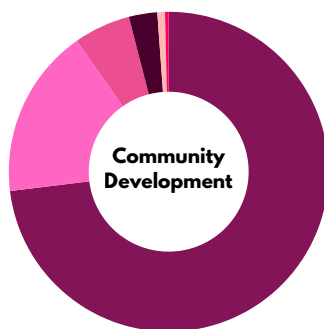

YDD forged new partnerships with Pejabat Pendidikan Daerah Bangsar Pudu for a new programme, Secondary Day School sponsorship and Pahang Skills for TVET sponsorship.

# 2024 HIGHLIGHTS

## LIVELIHOOD PROGRAMME IMPACT

The livelihood of 3 Bidayuh communities in Sarawak improved with income from organic crops and food processing surged - Kg. Sting (3000% increase), Kg. Muk Ayun (674% increase), Kg Nyegol (9% increase) since the inception of the programme.



## STRENGTHENED ALUMNI NETWORK

YDD Alumni Network has taken on a more active role in giving back to the YDD community by strategizing and executing programmes for scholars, with more activities planned for 2025.

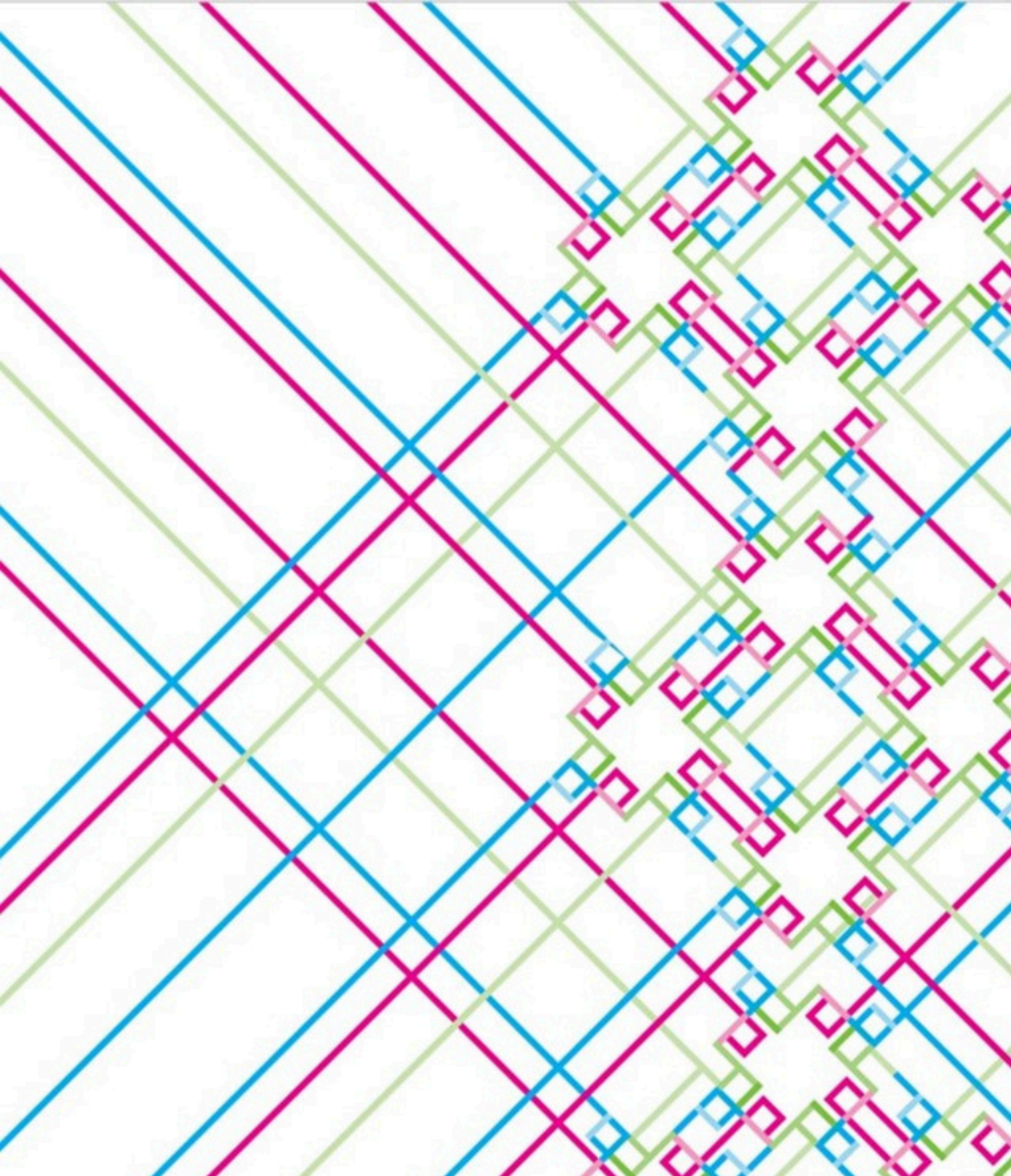
